



The Churches of Garden Grove Walk “THE WAY OF THE CROSS”

The Christian churches of Garden Grove are uniting again to sponsor interdenominational services and processions on Good Friday, March 30, beginning at 12 noon and ending at 3:00 p.m.

“The Way of the Cross” will be celebrated at the following churches:

Each brief service (except the last) will be followed by a procession to the succeeding church. You may join (or leave) the services at any time or place, and walk as much as you feel able. Cars will be following along the way to assist any participants who may have difficulty completing the walk.

The service at each church will focus on the “Stations of the Cross”, the historic, meditative points of Jesus’ journey of obedience. The procession will be led by a cross and banners identifying participants as walking “The Way of the Cross.” This is a unique opportunity to reach out and witness to our community, as well as to participate in meaningful worship with fellow Christians.

The processions heighten the awareness of our Savior’s death and draws attention to the many people, from different denominations in Garden Grove, who are committed to Christ. Last year about 500 people participated in the services and walk.

Please join fellow Christians on this Good Friday afternoon for an inspiring opportunity to worship and witness.

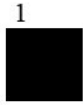
